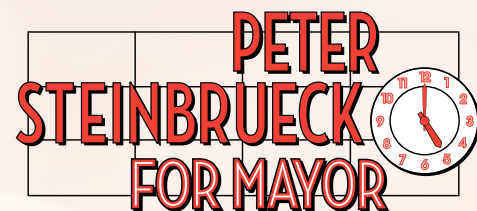
“We are one of the country's largest port cities, with a rich 150-year maritime history. We compete globally in health and technology, aerospace, art and music. I'm proud of our city.
