Seattle Proposition 1 - Seattle Parks District

This proposition would create a metropolitan park district, called the Seattle Park District, to provide ongoing funding to maintain, operate and improve parks, community centers, pools, and other recreation facilities and programs. The District would have the same boundaries as the City of Seattle and be governed by a board composed of the Seattle City Councilmembers. The District could exercise powers under state law to levy property taxes and contract with the City to perform the District's functions.
